1. Health & Safety – Disclosure of Information

As mandated by the Health & Safety at Work Act and all subsequent relevant legislation, ICIL require full disclosure of all material facts pertaining to the composition & behaviour of the product(s) to be tested, insofar as they may impact upon the health & safety of ICIL's employee.

Prior to the delivery of any samples or bulk materials to ICIL's site, the client shall provide a detailed MSDS – Material Safety Data Sheet – or equivalent, PERTAINING SPECIFICALLY TO THE SAMPLES TO BE DELIVERED.

The client shall equally disclose any other information that may be relevant to health and safety under the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations in India. This shall include but not be limited to any radioactive or explosive characteristics.

ICIL management shall be the sole arbiter in deciding, on the basis of information provided, that it is safe and prudent to conduct test work on the designated material(s).

2. Scheduling

The duration of a test normally is completed in a day. A date is allocated & advised to the client accordingly.

ICIL will make every endeavour to adhere to agreed dates for conducting trials but cannot absolutely guarantee that the work will be completed to this schedule.

3. Test Charges

Charges for the use of the selected equipment is:

INR 60,000 /- per day + Tax(if any).

of testing. Charges are generally **refundable** against subsequent order if the order is effective within a 4 months period after the tests.

Test charge shall include provision of:

- Reasonable levels of manpower.
- Consumables – electricity, fuel, water and compressed air.
- ICIL's standard laboratory facilities for moisture content evaluation.

Days charged are normally only for those involved specifically in conducting the test program. Time spent in preparing the plant and in post-test clean-up is not charged. However, in exceptional circumstances, where the client has special requirements for plant preparation or there are unusual clean-up demands, additional days may, by agreement, be charged.

Charges will be invoiced before the start of the test program and shall be paid before that date. If ICIL doesn't receive the payment in time, test can be deferred until payment is authorized.

4. Other Charges

The client shall be responsible for the costs, including any duties and taxes, of delivering his material(s) to ICIL's test plant and for the return cost of transport to his assigned destination. The client shall also be responsible for the provision of any special packaging required for the return of the products.

At its discretion, ICIL reserves the right to charge the client for mailing or couriering samples of products, should such costs become significant.

Should any specialist equipment, not already in ICIL's inventory, be required for the testing, hire or other procurement of such equipment shall be to the client's account. The cost of such procurement will be agreed with the client in advance.

5. Equipment Integrity

ICIL will present the selected equipment in a clean condition but it cannot guarantee that cross-contamination from previously trialed materials will not occur. It is recommended that products from the trials should not be used for further production purposes, nor for consumption.

ICIL accepts no responsibility for contamination or loss of client's material.

Should the client have any specific requirements concerning the handling of his materials, these shall be disclosed prior to any testing taking place.

6. Attendance

The client is encouraged to attend the test program and to offer such guidance in its performance as his experience shall provide.

The costs incurred in such attendance shall be to the client's own account.

Whilst on ICIL's premises, the client's representatives will be expected to adhere to the health and safety regulations governing the site.

Should it be impracticable for the client to attend the trials, he should nominate a contact to whom ICIL may report and discuss progress.
